## Language Resources and How to Get Assistance

By responding to the census, you help your family and community get funding for essential services like schools, healthcare, and highways. Be counted!

- ✓ You can fill out an **ONLINE CENSUS QUESTIONNAIRE** in English, Spanish, Chinese (Simplified), Vietnamese, Korean, Russian, Arabic, Tagalog, Polish, French, Haitian Creole, Portuguese, and Japanese.

*You can respond to the census online starting in March 2020.*

- ✓ You can **RESPOND TO THE QUESTIONNAIRE by PHONE** in English, Spanish, Chinese (Mandarin & Cantonese), Vietnamese, Korean, Russian, Arabic, Tagalog, Polish, French, Haitian Creole, Portuguese, and Japanese.

*You can call to respond to the census by phone starting in March 2020.*

- ✓ You can fill out a **PAPER CENSUS QUESTIONNAIRE** in English or Spanish.

*The Census Bureau will mail you a form in March or April 2020.*

The Census Bureau has resources to help you understand the English language questionnaire. These will be available at [www.2020census.gov](http://www.2020census.gov).

**Written Language Guides.** This is a translated *sample* version of the questionnaire. You cannot fill it out, but you can reference it when you fill out the English version.

**Video Language Guides.** This is a video that explains what the questionnaire says and asks.

**Language Glossaries.** This is a document with translations of census terms.
